## **Januvaru, Kukkuta, Matsya & Krishi Mela-2013**

The Karnataka Veterinary, Animal & Fisheries Sciences University (KVAFSU), Bidar, organised a “Januvaru, Kukkuta, Matsya & Krishi Mela - 2013” during March 1-3, 2013 at Veterinary College, Shivamogga. The mela was inaugurated by Dr. C. Renukprasad, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, KVAFSU, Bidar. Dr. M. Devaraj, Dean, VCS, presided over the Inaugural Ceremony. Sri. M.V. Vedamurthy, Deputy Commissioner, Shivamogga was the Chief Guest. Sri. T. Mukund Varma, Dr. D.R. Nagesh and Dr. (Smt.) Vishalaxi, V. Kareddy, Hon'ble Members of Board of Management, KVAFSU, Bidar and Dr. K.N. Prabhudeva, Director of Extension, KVAFSU, Bidar were the Guest of Honours. All the Officers of the University and farmers attended the Inaugural Ceremony. Dr. K.C. Veeranna, Professor & Head and Member Secretary of the mela welcomed the dignitaries, guests and farmers. A book on 'Pashu aadharita kirunatakagala sankalana' was brought out by the Directorate of Extension, was released during the occasion.

A total of 123 stalls were erected for displaying research and extension activities of different Agricultural Universities and development departments. In addition to this, KVAFSU and private entrepreneurs and industries displayed their activities. More than 10000 farmers attended the mela in three days. Different types and breeds of livestock namely, cattle (Malenadu Gidda, Deoni, Khillar, Kankarj, Ongole, Gir etc.), buffaloes (Murra, Surti, Jafferbadi etc.), horses, dogs, sheep, goat, rabbit and poultry birds, fodder crops and fishes (food and ornamental) were displayed. Technical Consultancy was given to the farmers different aspects of agriculture, fisheries, dairy and livestock farming. Twenty five progressive farmers shared their experiences with other farmers in Farmers-to-Farmers interaction meet. Inaugurating the seminar, Dr. A.K. Srivatsava, Director and Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, NDRI, Karnal, in his key note address, gave an account of the contributions of NDRI to strengthen the Act, to provide technical support in fixing/proposing standards for various dairy foods and continue to provide clarifications on safety issues. The inaugural function was chaired by Dr. C. Renuka Prasad, Hon'ble Vice chancellor, KVAFUS, Bidar. In the concluding session Dr. C.S. Prasad, Director, NIANP, Bengaluru, observed that good breeding and feeding habits, good animal farm management practices would go a long way in preventing the entry of pesticide, insecticide, veterinary drugs, mycotoxin and antibiotic residues into milk at the farm. He also expressed concern at low fat and SNF content in some of the crossbred cow's milk. Dr. K.N. Prabhudeva, Director of Extension, KVAFSU, Bidar and Smt. B.M. Leelavathi, Consultant, NMFP, Directorate of Agriculture, GOK graced the occasion.
