This is the sixth issue of news letter of our University in your hands for the period from July to December, 2007. I am extremely happy to note that the University has been steadily progressing in education, research and extension. Two more Veterinary Colleges at Shimoga and Hassan district were started and functioning. One more Dairy Science College at Gulbarga district and an Institute for Wild Live Veterinary Medicine at Coorg have been started and works initiated. The University has expanded in all directions in the State.

The students of the University are also excelled in studies and a good number of Junior Research Fellowships were bagged at all India level. All the Key Officers posts of the University were filled up through direct recruitment during the period. Under Career Advance Scheme most of the eligible teachers were given promotions. Backlog teaching posts have been advertised. Non teaching faculty posts particularly for the new colleges at Shimoga and Hassan were advertised and shortly filled up. Research and Extension Activities have been strengthened with the appointment of regular Directors. A good number of training programmes were organized during the period.
