I. IMPORTANT EVENTS ORGANISED

“Januvaru, Matsya, Krishi & Totagarika Mela-2011” organized at KVAFSU, Bidar during December 28-30, 2011

The Karnataka Veterinary, Animal & Fisheries Sciences University (KVAFSU), Bidar, University of Agricultural Sciences Raichur and University of Horticultural Sciences, Bagalkot, jointly organised “Januvaru, Matsya, Krishi & Totagarika Mela - 2011” during December 28-30, 2011 at KVAFSU, Nandinagar Campus, Bidar for the benefit of farming community. The mela was inaugurated by Shri. Revu Naik Belamagi, Hon’ble Minister for Animal Husbandry & Pro-Chancellor of the University and opined that this type of melas will help the farming community for improving their livelihood. Prof. Suresh, S. Honnappagol, Hon’ble Vice-Chancellor presided over the Inaugural Ceremony. Dr. B.V. Patil, Hon’ble Vice Chancellor, UAS, Raichur, Dr. S.A. Patil, Hon’ble Chairman, Karnataka Krishi Mission; Hon’ble Members of Board of Management, KVAFSU and all the Officers of the University and farmers attended the Inaugural Ceremony. Dr. K. N. Prabhudeva, Director of Extension, KVAFSU, Bidar was the Chairman of the mela. 5 publications and a CD on success story on Integrated fish farming in Raichur District brought out by the University, were released during the occasion.

In this mela 140 stalls were erected and displayed research and extension activities by different Agricultural Universities and State Departments, Bidar Zilla Panchayath namely, Fisheries, Animal Husbandry, Agriculture, KMF, Watershed Development and other Departments of the State in addition to stalls organised by the KVAFSU. Further, a good number of stalls from private entrepreneurs and industries were also set up and displayed the activities. More than 25000 farmers attended during these three days and benefited. This mela was organised as a means of transfer of technology in Agriculture, Animal Husbandry, Dairy, Fisheries and other related areas. The main attraction of the mela was exhibition of different breeds of livestock namely, cattle (Deoni, Khillar, Gir etc.), buffaloes (Murrah, Surti, Jaffarabadi etc.), horses, camels, dogs, sheep, goat, rabbit and different types of poultry birds including some of the rare breeds, fodder crops and fishes namely, food fishes, ornamental fishes etc. Technical Consultancy Cell was established to give technical guidance on different aspects of agriculture, aquaculture, fisheries, dairy and livestock farming for the benefit of farming community. Interesting dog skill show was also arranged on 29th for the benefit of children, farmers and public.

Best farmer awards were presented to 13 farmers which included livestock as well as fish farmers selected from different districts of Karnataka. Breed wise best livestock animals were selected and prizes were given away. Overall ‘Champion Animal’ bagged 1st prize of Rs. 10,000/- and several other prizes were given away during the mela.



The valedictory function was held on 30-12-2011 evening. Prof. Suresh, S. Honnappagol, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, KVAFSU, presided over, Dr. K.N. Prabhudeva, Director of Extension & Chairman of Organizing Committee welcomed the dignitaries & all the guests and presented a brief report of three days mela activities. Sri. H. S. Veerappa Gowda, Director of Fisheries, GOK was the Chief Guest. Dr. S. B. Dandin, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, University of Horticultural Sciences (UHS), Bagalkot; Dr. Hanchinal, Director of Extension, UAS, Raichur, Dr. Y. K. Kotekal, Director of Extension, UHS, Bagalkot, Dr. Vishalakshi Kareddi, Hon'ble Member, Board of Management, KVAFSU, Bidar, Sri. Allama Prabhu, Member of Board of Management, UAS, Raichur & MLC, Officers and staff of KVAFSU, Bidar and large number of farmers were present.

The most important impact of the mela was Farmers-to-Farmers interaction in the fields of dairying, fisheries, horticulture, agriculture, seed production, organic farming on all the 3 days in 4 sessions where more than 25 progressive farmers shared their experiences among fellow farmers.

The programme was well received by the farmers and public as per the feed back received from them and a good awareness was created about integrated farming involving agriculture, animal husbandry and fisheries; livestock farming activity as a source of livelihood security and fish and its utility. The Fair was very well covered in the media both in press and in electronic media (TV & Doordarshan).
