The KVAFSU-CVA Rabies Diagnostic Laboratory is designated as OIE Reference Laboratory for Rabies as per the communication from the Director General, OIE, Paris, France dated 16th June, 2020. This is the first in South Asian Region comprising of 7 countries including India and Southeast Asian region comprising of 11 countries. This Laboratory is the 12th OIE Reference Laboratory for Rabies in the World. The major responsibilities for this laboratory are providing scientific excellence and technical inputs to these Asian regions with reference to harmonization of Rabies surveillance in animals, Development of Human Resource, Quality assurance and Standardization of Biologicals, Inter laboratory Comparisons and proficiency testing. In general, the laboratory will be playing a pivotal role in South and South East Asian regions for the animal rabies related activities. This development is a feather not only on the cap of KVAFSU but also Karnataka and India.
