From the Vice-Chancellor's Desk

It gives me great pleasure to put forth the News Letter of our University highlighting the major activities undertaken during January to June 2014.

With India progressing towards an exciting future of growth and development in almost all spheres of activity, the niche fields such as animal husbandry, dairy, poultry and fisheries also need to contribute in a big way boosting food production and helping the farmers to augment their income. In this direction, our university has initiated efforts to empower the marginal farmers of dry land agriculture to take up sheep and goat farming (also called ATM of farmer, where cash can be realized by the farmer even at mid night selling his goats) at different centers of Livestock Research and Information Centers. Our University is making efforts to upgrade the local sheep and goat breeds for better growth and performance.

In the academic circle large number of ICAR-JRF rank holders have emerged successful in the All India Competitive Exam. It is heartening to note that one of our Veterinary graduate has entered into Indian Administrative Service with the 517th rank.

I am pleased to note that our university has been identified as one of the consortium partners for the world bank assisted KWDP-II, Sujala-III project and sanctioned Rs. 9.364 crores to the university to undertake animal husbandry and fish culture activities in the farmers fields to support livelihood of farmers in seven backward districts of Karnataka.

In order to help shrimp farmers in coastal Karnataka to diagnose white spot viral disease in shrimps, College of Fisheries, Mangalore has commercialized the RapiDot kit which was released by the Hon'ble DG, ICAR, Dr. S. Ayyappan (the beauty of the kit is that it is farmer-friendly and economical), they have also designed women friendly Hygienic Fish Vending Table (patent pending). Our JAH&VB Scientists have provided diagnostic services for control of FMD in the state and for other livestock and poultry diseases.
