Objectives:-

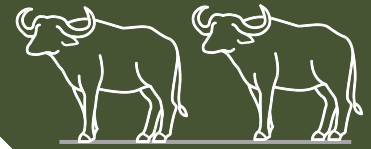
1. To highlight importance of extension approaches aimed at Sustainable Buffalo Production.
